RE: A Level Geography Fieldwork: 21st November 2017

For the A Level Geography course, students are required to undertake two days of fieldwork in contrasting locations around the UK. In order to meet the first half of this requirement, your son/daughter has been invited on a trip to Stratford-upon-Avon and Leamington Spa on Tuesday 21st November in order to collect data which we will then use to complete their independent investigation.

Students will need to meet Mrs Franklin and Mrs McLaurie in the Atrium of NBA at 8.30 in order to be registered and leave in the minibus for Stratford-upon-Avon. We will spend the morning in Stratford and then head back to Leamington Spa for the afternoon. Students will need to bring a small amount of money or a packed lunch; there will be opportunities in the towns to buy small amounts of food.

Students will need to follow the normal Academy sixth form dress code for the trip, but please ensure that shoes are comfortable for a day of walking around towns. Please ensure that students come to school equipped with a pen as they will need to make notes on their experiences, and a note pad to take notes. It may be a good idea to have a hard back note book or folder to lean on while collecting data on the day.

There is no cost associated with this trip. Please complete the attached consent form and medical form at the bottom of this letter, and return it to Miss Smith in the Geography department to confirm your place on the trip.
